**Veterans Inc. Receives Grant from the Nashoba Valley Community Healthcare Fund**

Grant will be used to Purchase Computers for the Organization's Devens, MA Housing Facility

**Worcester, MA** — Veterans Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit serving veterans in need and their families across New England, has been awarded a grant from the Nashoba Valley Community Healthcare Fund.

The \$13,957 grant from the Nashoba Valley Community Healthcare Fund is representative of individual awards consisting of \$5,816 from the Greater Lowell Community Foundation (GLCF) and \$8,141 from the Community Foundation of North Central Massachusetts (CFNCM).

The grant will be used to purchase computers for the organization's Devens, MA housing facility for veterans. Each computer will be loaded with VA sponsored software and applications designed to help veterans deal with stress, anxiety, and the long term effects of PTSD and TBI. With the purchase of the computers, veteran clients will be able to access these tools on their own time in the comfort and privacy of their individual living units.

Veterans Inc. is New England's leading provider of support services to veterans and their families. A 501(c)(3) nonprofit, the organization's single-minded mission is to be there for our veterans in their time of need. Incorporated in 1990, Veterans Inc. has helped more than 60,000 veterans in need and today operates offices and programs in all six New England states. The support services include housing programs, counseling, employment & training, family programs, benefits counseling and advocacy, transportation, temporary financial assistance, health and wellness, food services, and women & childcare services. In 2015, the agency was honored with the National Coalition for Homeless Veterans 2015 "Outstanding Member Award" in Washington.
