Veterans Inc. Receives Workforce Training Grant
Funding Provided through State's Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development

Boston – Veterans Inc., a 501c3 non-profit serving veterans in need and their families across New England, has been awarded a Workforce Training Fund grant from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development. The grant program is administered by Commonwealth Corporation.

This grant provides access to training that will greatly enhance our staff's ability to provide superior supportive services to our clients. Veterans, Inc. was awarded \$140,590 as part of the program, to train 62 workers.

"We applaud the administration's commitment to putting Massachusetts residents back to work, and we are thrilled to be a part of that. The announcement was made as part of a rollout of an \$8.47 million rollout of Workforce Training funding statewide.

Training topics that will be covered by Veterans Inc. include Auditing Strategies, Case Management Skills, Business Writing, Building Professional & Community Relationships, Coaching & Mentoring, Supervisory Management & Leadership Skills, Problem Solving & Corrective Actions, Program & Risk Management Strategies, and Team Management & Facilitating Groups.
