Veterans Inc. Receives Grant from the Greater Worcester Community Foundation

Grant will Support the Organization's Independence Hall Treatment Center

Shrewsbury, MA — Veterans Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit serving veterans in need and their families across New England, has been awarded a grant from the Greater Worcester Community Foundation.

The \$12,500 award will be used towards the creation of the Insurance Counselor position at the organization's Independence Hall Treatment Center, funding a portion of that position's salary. The Insurance Counselor will assist veteran clients in substance abuse treatment with insurance enrollment and the processing of their insurance coverage.

Opening this fall, the Independence Hall Treatment Center is located on twenty two acres in Shrewsbury, MA. The treatment center will offer a continuum of care to assist individuals in meeting their recovery goals and is open to adult men and women struggling with substance abuse issues. Services include inpatient treatment services, an intensive outpatient program, and outpatient counseling. As a subprogram of Veterans Inc., Independence Hall specializes in behavioral health services for service members and veterans.
