Our Support Services Include:

Emergency Shelter and Transitional Housing

Veterans Inc. provides emergency shelter, transitional services, and long-term housing to veterans of all ages and eras.



Case Management

Veterans Inc. works with each veteran to develop an individual treatment plan throughout all programs, by providing benefits counseling and advocacy in addition to a variety of other services.



Supportive Services for Veteran Families

Veterans Inc. provides housing stabilization and other supportive services including temporary financial assistance to rapidly rehouse homeless veterans or prevent homelessness for low income households.

Employment and Training

Veterans Inc. provides assistance with resume writing, short term trainings, job search and placement with additional specialized support for post 9/11 veterans.



Women and Families Support

Veterans Inc. provides shelter and services for female veterans with or without dependent children in a safe, nurturing, and developmentally appropriate environment for infants and children up to age 12.



Health and Wellness

Veterans Inc. provides access to food and clothing as well as physical, mental, and emotional care. Recreational activities, peer support, and community connection are also available.

Behavioral Health Services

Veterans Inc. operates the first-of-its-kind behavioral health treatment center focused on veteran recovery for those battling addiction, PTSD, mental illness, trauma, and depression. Licensed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) accredited, Veterans Inc. Behavioral Health Services provide, inpatient stabilization, residential rehabilitation, co-occurring enhanced residential care, and intensive outpatient counseling. Services are centrally located at both our Worcester headquarters site, and at our Shrewsbury site, Independence Hall, where Medication Assisted Treatment is fully supported as a primary recovery tool, and Women's Services provide specialized inpatient stabilization treatment to women with a substance use diagnosis.



Suicide Prevention Service

Services include outreach to identify those at risk of suicide, mental health screening, education on suicide risk and prevention for families and communities, access to clinical support for emergency services, and case management.
